PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF CLERK’S DEFAULT

Plaintiff Shenzhen Dejiayun Network Technology Co., Ltd. (“Plaintiff” or “Dejiayun”), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby requests that the Clerk enter default in this matter pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 55(a) against certain Defendant LUKISUZY identified in the Schedule A (D.E. 8-2) of the Complaint as Def. 21 (“Defaulting Defendant”) on the grounds that Defaulting Defendant has failed to appear or otherwise respond to the Complaint within the time prescribed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

1. On February 15, 2024, Defaulting Defendant was served with the Summons and a copy of the Complaint by email communication as authorized by this Court’s Order on Alternate Service. (D.E. 28).

2. The time allowed for Defendant to respond to the Complaint has expired. Neither Plaintiff nor the Court has granted Defendant an extension of time to respond to the Complaint.

Defendant has failed to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint, or serve a copy of any Answer or other response upon Plaintiff's attorney of record.

3. Plaintiff is informed and believes that Defendant is not considered an infant or incompetent person. Plaintiff is informed and believes that the Service Members Civil Relief Act does not apply.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Dejiayun requests that the Clerk enter default, as authorized by Fed.R.Civ.P. 55(a) against the Defaulting Defendant.
